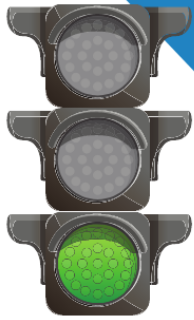
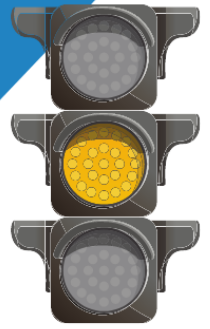

Fledglings will be left alone for long periods of time between parental feedings. If needed, use gloves to gently move a bird to a safer, nearby location. Example: from the side of the road to a nearby low bush.

Use a towel and gloves to pick up the bird. Keep it warm, let it rest. Do NOT give ANY food or water.
